- Clarify your objective to help you (and your audience) stay on track
- Decide what information and how much detail to include
- Open your presentations in a way that captures attention
- Use your voice and body language to enhance your credibility
- Design visuals with just enough content to support your message
- Manage audience interaction and respond effectively to questions

What to expect

This workshop is an intensive, hands-on, and enjoyable learning experience. Come with a presentation on a business topic of your choice. During the session, you edit and refine your draft based on strategies learned. As well, you have two opportunities to deliver your presentation and receive feedback from both your peers and the facilitator. In addition, you receive a recording of your presentation so you can evaluate your skills privately. You also receive a comprehensive manual, a laminated tip sheet and access to online resources for post-workshop use.
